Over the month of December, we have picked up **86** Fly tips from across the district and to give you a flavour what was picked up please see below:







We have had our last RIPA authority approved in December, so we have been getting our next round of covert cameras in place. We currently have 14 cameras out; this include temporary overt ones.

We have been successful in 2 court cases for fly tipping with fines being issued to the culprits by the courts and an additional waste carrier without the correct licences in place took and prosecuted in court too.

Since April 2021 we collected 743 fly tips which compared to last year (1737 from April-April) is a big decrease which is certainly going against national statistics which are seeing an increase year upon year of fly tipping reports.

TREE WORKS UPDATE

Tree Works

Our tree team are now officially completing tree works for our residents and businesses and have completed many jobs across the district, bringing additional income into the council and have received very positive feedback from all customers.

We have quoted on 207 Jobs since we started (November 2020) and have been successful in the customer accepting quote in over 60%. Also we are now seeing repeat customers which is a credit to the team.

We have received an increase in quotes/enquiries over the last few weeks as the good word regarding the service gets spread and we have received very positive feedback with the work undertaken.

We have also been working at Baggeridge Country Park alongside the rangers to help with the maintenance of the vast tree stock on the beautiful site.

We have ensured that any normal and emergency works will been completed by the in-house team rather than outsourcing to contractors, which in turn provides saving to the council.

Bulb Planting Events

We were so pleased to once again be able to hold our bulb planting events in November. The events at both cemeteries were well attended and everyone that came along thoroughly enjoyed getting out in the fresh air and getting some gentle exercise. At Strawberry Lane in Great Wyrley, despite the cold we had beautiful blue skies and an inquisitive robin who came to join us. At Sytch Lane in Wombourne we were joined by enthusiastic members of the public, members of the High Flyers Group and staff from Wombourne Funeral Services as well as our own staff who all worked really hard. We look forward to seeing the cemeteries full of colour in the spring.
