unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available.

- New Horse Road, Sutherland Road, Landywood Lane, B4156 High Street, B4156 Low Street and B4156 Station Street.
- B4156 Station Street, B4156 Station Road, A34 Walsall Road, Bell Lane, B4210 Broad Lane, A462 Warstone Road, B4156 Wolverhampton Road, B4156 Low Street and B4156 Station Street.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the Severn Trent Water works to facilitate an excavation and installation of a new gravity fed sewer, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the roads have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
